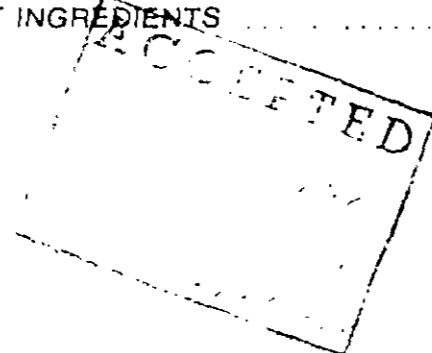

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Avoid breathing dust. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. If in eyes, rinse eyes for at least 15 minutes with water and call a physician immediately. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating or smoking. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Get medical attention immediately. If inhaled remove victim to fresh air and apply respiration if indicated. If on skin, wash promptly with soap and water, rinse thoroughly. If in eyes, rinse eyes for at least 15 minutes with water and call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN AND VETERINARIAN

Zoecon RF-48 Beef Cattle and Swine Dust is an organophosphorous insecticide. Atropine is antidotal. Usual symptoms of organophosphorous poisoning in man include: headache, blurred vision, weakness, nausea, discomfort in the chest, vomiting, abdominal cramps, diarrhea, salivation, sweating, pinpoint pupils. Usual symptoms of organophosphorous poisoning in animals include salivation and labored breathing.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish and wildlife. Keep out of lakes, streams or ponds. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Zoecon RF-48 Beef Cattle and Swine Dust is a ready-to-use insecticide dust for the control of lice on cattle and swine as a hand application. The applicator should wear protective gloves when applying this product. This dust also controls Hornflies on cattle as a dust bag treatment and aids in the control of Faceflies. Do not apply within one day of slaughter. Do not use on dairy cattle. Do not place dust bag near dairy cows or milking apparatus.

ANIMAL	INSECT	USE INSTRUCTIONS
Beef Cattle	Hornflies & Lice	SELF-TREATING DUST BAG Forced Use: Put Zoecon RF-48 Beef Cattle and Swine Dust in dust bags and hang in barn door exits or alleyways leading from animal buildings. Hang near salt or mineral blocks or watering holes. Protect dust bags from weather. Free Choice Use: Place dust bags in loafing sheds, holding pens, feedlots, near watering holes or other areas where cattle gather.
	Hornflies & Faceflies	HAND DUSTING Apply 1 ounce of dust per adult animal. Use proportionately smaller quantities for younger animals. Apply to upper portions of back, neck and poll and lightly rub in. Retreat as necessary.
	Lice	Apply 1/2 ounce of dust per 100 pounds of body weight not to exceed 4 ounces per animal. Apply to upper portions of back, neck and poll and lightly rub in. Retreat as necessary.
Swine	Lice	HAND DUSTING Apply 1/2 to 1 ounce of dust per animal to backline and lightly rub in. Repeat in 10 to 14 days or as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or food by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container.

Product that cannot be used should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides or buried in a safe place away from water supplies.

Empty containers should be disposed of in an incinerator or landfill approved for pesticide containers, or buried in a safe place.

Consult federal, state or local disposal authorities for approved alternative procedures such as limited open burning.
