

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

- 1. Buckle collar around dog's neck. [Thread flat end of the collar through buckle hole and tighten as necessary, so that at least two ridges are covered by the buckle. Since the plastic buckle is molded into the collar, the possibility of neck irritation and buckle failure is reduced.] Collar should fit snug enough to prevent placement of the dog's leg or lower jaw through the collar, yet loose enough to be rotated about the neck. [Generally, if used on large dogs, two or three fingers should fit between the collar and dog's neck.] •
