The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below prior to release for shipment of product bearing the amended labeling.

- Delete the phrases "Birth Control for Fleas" and "Birth Control Ingredient." Words or phrases implying that a product possesses unique characteristics, such as prevention of conception in fleas, are unacceptable.

Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS-CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly after handling. Do not use in edible product areas of food processing plants, restaurants, or commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is being prepared or served. Do not use in aquariums covered or removed before treatment. Do not allow children to lie on floors following treatment.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT: If swallowed - Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Note to Physician: May present aspiration hazard. Atropine should be given if cholinesterase inhibition appears. If inhaled - Remove victim to fresh air. Apply to skin - Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water. DIRECTIONS FOR USE - It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Use one (fogger) canister for each 6,000 cu. ft. (750 sq. ft.) of unobstructed area (12' rooms). For most effective results, entire dwelling should be treated. Use of full flow of mist is not assured.

No need to discard pet bedding after treatment. Be sure to leave pet bedding and [adult and hatching fleas [preadult (larvae) fleas] [adult fleas and hatching eggs (larvae)]

Place in middle of the room on [the floor or a raised area such as a table or under can to [protect the surface] prevent any surface marring. Extinguish all open flames at least six feet away from pilot lights. Close [outside] all doors and windows. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Cover or remove any exposed foods. Cover cabinets and doors to areas to be treated. (Open cupboards, closets, trunks and suitcases, [leave rug, drapes, slip covers, upholstered furniture in place. Used as directed to kill fleas (adult and preadult fleas) hiding inside.]

Keep at arm's length when releasing. Point top of can away from face and eyes. Press down actuator tab to lock in position to start fogging. Leave building [treated area] at once. Leave undisturbed for two hours. [Upon release] air for 1 hour.

ALTERNATE DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

One can treats an area of 6,000 cubic feet (25' X 30' with an 8' ceiling). Fog should be treated. Use additional cans for remote rooms or where full flow of mist is not assured.

Preparation:

1. Open all cabinet doors and drawers to allow maximum kill in areas where infested foods, dishes, utensils, food processing equipment and surfaces. and bowls. Leave pet bedding exposed.

2. Close doors and windows and shut off fans and air conditioners. Extinguish all open flames within 6 feet of pilot light.

Directions:

- Place can on stand or table in center of room with newspaper under can.
- With can at arm's length, tilt can away from face
- Push down firmly with thumb on sprayer tab until it snaps into place.
- Put the can on newspaper. Leave immediately and close the door.
- Leave treated area for 2 hours.
- After 2 hours, open all doors and windows and allow to air for 1 hour.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Store in cool area away from children. Do not flush collection.
