PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS-WARNING: Causes eye irritation. Do not get in eyes. Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing mist. Avoid contact with skin. Wash thoroughly after handling.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT: If swallowed - Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Do not induce vomiting. Note to Physician: May present aspiration hazard. Atropine should be administered only if symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition appear. If inhaled - Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated. If on skin - Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water. If in eyes - Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician immediately.

Avoid contamination of food and foodstuffs. Do not use in edible product areas of food processing plants, restaurants, or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS: Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flames. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting. Do not puncture or incinerate.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE - It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Use at least one canister for each 12,000 cubic feet (1500 square feet) of unobstructed area, (approximately 39' x 39' or twelve 10' x 12' rooms). For most effective results, entire dwelling should be treated. Use additional cans for remote rooms or where full flow of mist is not assured.

Remove pets. Be sure to leave pet bedding as this is a primary hiding place for fleas and must be treated to get best results. No need to discard pet bedding after treatment. Fish tanks or bowls should either be covered with paper or removed.

Place in middle of the room on a table or floor. Place newspapers under can to prevent any surface marring. Extinguish all open flames except pilot lights. Place at least six feet away from pilot lights. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Close all doors and windows. Cover or remove any exposed foods. Cover dishes and food handling equipment. Open cabinets and doors to areas to be treated.

Keep at arm's length when releasing. Point top of can away from face and eyes. Press down actuator tab to lock in position to start fogging action. Set in upright position and leave building at once. Leave undisturbed for two hours. Open doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
