Use at least one [fogger] canister for each 12,000 cu. ft. (1000 sq. ft.) of unobstructed area, (approximately 30' x 30' twelve 10' x 12' rooms). For most effective results, entire dwelling should be treated. Use additional cans for extra rooms or where full flow of mist is not assured.

Remove pets. Be sure to leave pet bedding as this is a primary hiding place for fleas (adult and pre-adult fleas) and must be treated to get best results. No need to discard pet bedding after treatment. Fish tanks or bowls should either be covered with paper or removed.

Place in middle of the room on [the floor or a raised area such as a table or chair] a table or floor. Place newspaper under can to [protect the surface] prevent any surface marring. Extinguish all open flames except pilot lights. Place least six feet away from pilot lights. Close [outside] all doors and windows [and turn off fans and air conditioner]. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Cover or remove any exposed foods. Cover dishes and food handling equipment. If cabinets and doors to areas to be treated. [Upon cupboards, closets, trunks and interior doors in area to be treated. [Leave rug, drapes, slip covers, upholstered furniture in place. Used as directed, this product will not harm them, just the fleas (adult and preadult fleas) hiding inside.]

Keep at arm's length when releasing. Point top of can away from face and eyes. [Keep at arm's length, point top of can away from face and eyes.] Press down actuator tab to lock in position to start fogging action. Set in upright position and leave building [treated area] at once. Leave undisturbed for two hours. [Upon return] Open doors and windows and allow air for 30 minutes.
