PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDOUS TO MAN & DOMESTIC ANIMALS: Irritant if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing mist. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Wash thoroughly after handling. Avoid contamination of food and foodstuffs. Do not use in edible product areas of food processing plants, restaurants, or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed. Pets should be removed and from apartments vacated or removed before treatment. Do not allow children to live or sleep in treated areas until at least six hours following treatment.

STATEMENT OF FIRST AID TREATMENT: If swallowed - Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Do not induce vomiting. Write to physician. May present respiratory hazards. Attention should be administered only if symptoms of cholinesterase inhibitor appear. If inhaled - Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated. If on skin - Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water. If in eyes - Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS: Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flames. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting. Do not burn or incinerate.

VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Use one canister for each 12,000 cu. ft. (1500 sq. ft.) of unobstructed area, (approximately 9' x 9' or twelve 10' x 12' rooms). For most effective results, entire dwelling should be treated. Use additional cans for remote rooms or where full flow of mist is not assured.

Do not discard pet bedding after treatment. Be sure to leave pet bedding as this is a primary hiding place for fleas and must be treated to get best results.

Place in middle of the room on a table or floor. Place newspapers under can to prevent any surface marking. Extinguish all open flames except pilot lights. Place all heat sources feet away from pilot lights. Shut off fans and air conditioning. Close all doors and windows. Cover or remove any exposed foods, dishes, dishes and food handling equipment. Open cabinets and doors to dress to be treated.

Keep at arm's length when releasing. Point top of can away from face and eyes. Press down button until it locks in position to start fogging action. Set in upright position and leave fogging at once. Leave and started for two hours. Open doors and windows and allow fresh air to circulate.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL: Store in cool area away from children. Do not store in garages, basements, or other areas where children play.

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records.

Note the following chemistry comments which will need to be addressed for future amendment action involving data support.

1. The applicant must supply specific upper and lower limits for each active and intentionally added inert ingredient. In addition, please include a brief discussion as to how these limits were established.

Note that according to present regulations and policy, the label claim for each active ingredient must not be more than the lower certified limit for that ingredient.

2. Please provide the density/specific gravity of this product-- it is not N.A.
3. Please provide a viscosity measurement on the concentrate without propellant.
4. We strongly prefer to see intermediate analyses during a storage stability. If they are available, please submit them. However, the report included with this submission is acceptable as minimum evidence of satisfactory stability.
