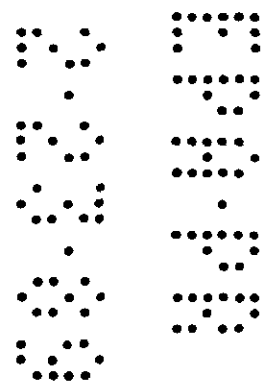

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labelling.

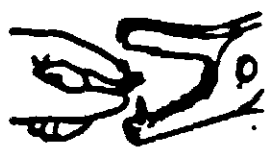
**For Hornfly Control:**

Apply tags when flies first appear in early spring. One Zoecon RF-268 Ear Tag per animal will provide up to 3 months control.

**For Gulf Coast Tick:**

Apply tags when ticks first appear. One tag in each ear will give season long control.

Apply tags to one or both ears as indicated above, one tag per ear, using the Temple Tag Herdsman applicator as instructed below:



1. Slide rivet onto pin.



2. Place tag under retainer plate. Raised square must be facing up. Tag and rivet are now ready for application.

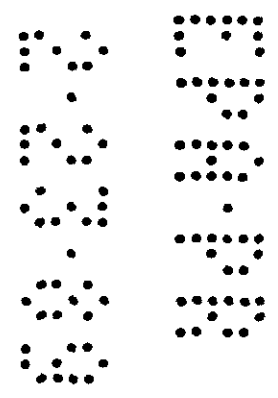


3. Position tag on the flat surface in center of ear. Do not allow shaft of the rivet to penetrate any cartilage or blood vessel. Ear damage may result.



4. When properly positioned, the tag should hang as shown.

Replace as necessary.



LIMITATIONS

Use these tags on beef cattle and nonlactating cattle, only. Do not apply on lactating dairy cattle.

### STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Remove tags before slaughter. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage: Do not remove tags from outer container until ready to use.

Pesticide Disposal: Discard used tags on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

Container Disposal: Dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or, if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of ke.
