b. The stated upper certified limits for DDVP and(s)-methoprene and Propoxur indicate an overformulation of approx. 169% for DDVP, 110% for Propoxur, and 66% for (s)-methoprene. Please narrow the range of these limits.		
3. We have reviewed the data supporting the biological activity of the (s)-methoprene and have the following comments: The test results indicate that (s)-methoprene was comparable to racemic methoprene through 161 days for flea control. The lack of emergence at 123 days was due to low survivability of fleas at that time of year.
