INTRODUCTION: Zoecon RF-291 Emulsifiable Concentrate [contains the insect growth regulator, S-Methoprene, which] acts on the immature life stages of the flea, preventing the adult flea from developing. Flea eggs deposited on, and larvae crawling onto treated areas will not develop into adult fleas. Existing adult fleas and flea pupae are not affected.

If a high population of adult fleas (the biting stage) is present, tank-mix with an adulticide of choice that is EPA registered and properly labeled for flea control. Use Zoecon RF-291 Emulsifiable Concentrate prior to the flea season as a preventative treatment. To prevent infestations before they start, apply Zoecon RF-291 Emulsifiable Concentrate prior to flea season.

When applied to surfaces where fleas are found, such as carpets, upholstered furniture, and pet sleeping areas, Zoecon RF-291 Emulsifiable Concentrate prevents adult flea emergence for up to 7 months [210 days].

METHOD AND RATE OF APPLICATION: Prepare a diluted spray solution with a final S-Methoprene concentration of approximately 0.007%, by adding 1 oz of Zoecon RF-291 Emulsifiable Concentrate to 1 gallon of water. Partially fill the mixing container with ½ gallon of water, add Zoecon RF-291 Emulsifiable Concentrate, shake well, and then add the remaining ½ gallon of water. Shake well before each use. When tank-mixing, follow the directions above except add the product to tank mix first, agitate, and then add Zoecon RF-291 Emulsifiable Concentrate, agitate and complete filling of spray tank, and agitate once more.

Apply at a rate of 1 gallon of the diluted spray solution per 1500 sq ft of surface area with any low pressure sprayer with a fan tip that is typically used for indoor applications. Treat all areas harboring fleas, including carpets, furniture, pet sleeping and bedding areas, and throw rugs. Treat under cushions of upholstered furniture. Avoid contact with treated surfaces until dry. When applying to upholstery where staining could be a concern, apply dilution to a small inconspicuous location to determine if possible staining could occur. Generally, RF291 Emulsifiable Concentrate will not stain areas that would not be stained by water alone.
