

Existing adult horn flies will not be affected. Start feeding before horn flies appear and continue use until cold weather marks the end of the horn fly season. Use the following management techniques to maintain continuous intake of Zoëcon Block IGR Cattle Supplement at a level of 1/4 - 1/2 lb per 100 lb of animal body weight per month.

- 1. Assure cattle are not starved for nutrients in Zoëcon Block IGR Cattle Supplement by providing them prior to feeding Zoëcon Block IGR Cattle Supplement.
- 2. Offer cattle 50 lb of Zoëcon Block IGR Cattle Supplement for every 15 head of cattle.
- 3. Remove all other self limiting nutritional supplements.
