

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INTRODUCTION: Zoecon RF-292 Briquets are designed to release methoprene insect growth regulator over a period up to 150 days at breeding sites. Release of methoprene insect growth regulator causes dissolution of the briquet. Soft mud and loose sediment are displaced and inhibit normal dispersion of the active ingredient. This is effective in those situations where the briquet can be placed in a flushing action.

Zoecon RF-292 Briquets prevents the emergence of adult Anopheles, Culex, Culiseta, Coquillettidia, and Mansonia spp. of the floodwater mosquito complex (Aedes and Psorophora spp.) in water. Treated larvae continue to develop normally to the pupal stage and they die.

NOTE: Methoprene insect growth regulator has no effect on larvae that have reached the pupal or adult stage prior to treatment.

PRECAUTIONS: Do not apply to known fish habitat.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

APPLICATION TIME: Placement of Zoecon RF-292 Briquets should be made at the beginning of the mosquito season. Zoecon RF-292 Briquets should be placed in flooding when sites are dry, or on snow and ice in the spring when the snow thaws. Under normal conditions, one application per mosquito season, or up to 150 days, whichever is shorter, will provide drying will not reduce their effectiveness.

APPLICATION RATES:
Aedes and Psorophora spp.: For control in non-culicid depressions (< 2 feet in depth), treat on the basis of 1 Methoprene Briquet per 200 ft². Briquets should be placed in alternate breeding sites to maintain continuous control in alternately flooded and dries up.

Culex, Culiseta and Anopheles spp.: Place 1 Zoecon RF-292 Briquet per 100 ft².

Coquillettidia and Mansonia spp.: For application to cattail bogs, water hyacinth beds, or other sites. For control place 1 briquet per 100 ft².

APPLICATION SITES: Zoecon RF-292 Briquets are designed to be used in small bodies of water which are not known fish habitat. Typical application sites are: storm drains, catch basins, roads and fountains, cesspools and septic tanks, waste water flooded crypts, transformer vaults, abandoned swimming pools, other man-made depressions, cattail marshes, cranberry bogs, pastures, meadows, rice fields, freshwater swamps, tidal marshes, woodland pools, flood plains and dredge spoils.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool place. Do not contaminate storage or disposal. Do not reuse empty container.

DISPOSAL: Dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning, or by incineration.
