3. The following statements must be deleted from the labeling since they are too promising and/or unsupported:

- a) Frees Bees Hives Colonies of Varroa.
- b) Prevent Economic Loss Due to Varroa.
- c) For Certifying Bee Hives [Colonies] Free of Varroa Mites [For Shipping].
- d) For Detecting Varroa Mites in Commercial Package Bees.
- e) Free Commercial Package Bees of Varroa.

4. Delete the term, "General Classification".

5. Add a referral statement to the front panel, i.e., "See Side Panel for Additional Precautions/Directions."

C) Within 14 months form date of this Notice you must submit a storage stability study for this product. The formulated product must be analyzed for its active ingredient at time zero and during a year of storage. The storage should be in warehouse conditions of temperature and humidity and stored in similar containers you will be using in the trade.

4. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for further description of final printed labeling.
