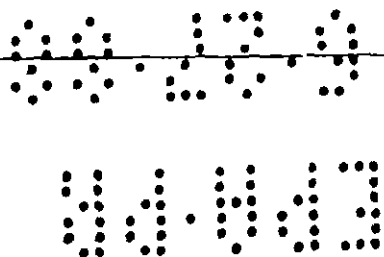

4. Cover or remove fish tanks and bowls. Cover stereo covers, and notion boxes. Do not use in food storage areas. Leave rugs, drapes, slip covers in place. Used as directed this product will not be hiding inside.
5. Place fogger on a raised area such as a table, covering the area directly under the can.
6. Keeping at arm's length, point top of can in position and lock in position and start fogging. After 2 hours, open all doors and windows, turn on fan and let the treated area air for 30 minutes.
7. After 2 hours, open all doors and windows, turn on fan and let the treated area air for 30 minutes.
8. All food processing surfaces should be covered and cleaned before using.
