Your Applications Dated August 15, 1995

The amendments referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, are acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below prior to release for shipment of product bearing the amended labeling.

1. For all subject products, make the following label changes:
  - a. Delete the statement "[Low VOC Product] Meets Reduced Volatile Organic Compounds Content Regulation". Terms stating or implying safety to the environment are not acceptable.
  - b. Add the following statements to the Directions For Use under **IMPORTANT!**:
    - †Shut off electrical equipment.
2. For EPA Reg. Nos. 2724-454 and 2724-457, delete the word "Exclusive" and the phrase "21 century technology" from the labeling since non-specific terminology or comparative words without valid comparison are unacceptable.
3. For EPA Reg. No. 2724 454, delete the phrases "unique combination" and "unique ingredient" from the labeling, since words or phrases implying that a product possesses unique characteristics because of its composition are not acceptable.

This product will kill fleas (adults and larvae), houseflies, gnats, ticks, cockroaches, carpet beetles, ants, spiders, flying moths, clothes moths, mosquitoes, silverfish, sawtoothed grain beetles, rice weevils, pill bugs, crickets, confused flour beetles, wasps, hornets, and palmetto bugs. **PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS**

**HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS - CAUTION: USE ONLY WHEN AREA TO BE TREATED IS VACATED BY HUMANS AND PETS.**

Harmful if inhaled, swallowed, or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. May cause eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after using. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists.

Remove pets and birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Remove all motor vehicles before using in garages.

**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT:** If swallowed - Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Do not induce vomiting. Note to physician: May present aspiration hazard. If inhaled - Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing give artificial respiration, preferably mouth to mouth. Call a physician if effects occur. If on skin - Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. If in eyes - Flush eyes with plenty of water. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists.

**PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS:** Extremely Flammable. Contents under pressure. Keep away from fire, sparks, and heated surfaces. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

Newspapers should be spread on the floor for several feet around area of release.

**IMPORTANT!** To avoid FLAMMABILITY HAZARD, use can as follows:

- Only one can per room.
- Do not place in cabinet or under counter or table.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:** It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not use in the food/feed areas of food/feed handling establishments, restaurants, or other areas where food/feed is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas where food/feed is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared foods/feeds are served such as dining rooms, but excluding areas where foods/feeds may be prepared or held. In the home, all food/feed processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food/feed should be covered or removed. Non-food/non-feed areas are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling). Not for use in USDA meat and poultry plants.

Close doors and windows. Open cabinets and doors within the treatment area. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Put out all open flames except pilot light. Place at least 6 feet away from pilot light. Fogger should be paced on floor in the middle of the room. Place newspapers under the container to prevent marring surfaces. Use one container for each 6000 [4000] [2000] cubic feet of area (a room 30' x 25' with an 8 foot ceiling). [20' x 25'] [10' x 25'] [coverage section simplified]

To start fogging: Press down actuator tab to lock in position. Keep at arm's length. Point top of can away from face and eyes. Set in upright position and leave the building at once. Leave undisturbed for 2 hours. Open doors and windows and allow to air for 1 hour.

[To start fogging: Keep at arm's length. Point top of can away from face and eyes. Press down actuator tab to lock in position. This engages the delayed release mechanism which will allow you time to quickly vacate the premises before the fogging agent is released [approximately within 30 - 60 seconds]. Set in upright position and leave the building at once. Leave undisturbed for 2 hours. Open doors and windows and allow to air for 1 hour.]

**STORAGE & DISPOSAL:** Storage: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame. DISPOSAL: Replace cap, wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
