HOW ZOECON RF 9307 Pump Spray WORKS [FOR BOT FLY CONTROLI:

[Zoecon RF 9307 Pump Spray combines the adult flea killing power of pyrethrins with the long-lasting egg-killing power of PRECOR® [vIGRen®] Insect Growth Regulator. This highly effective combination of ingredients provides quick relief from biting fleas and continuous killing of flea eggs laid on the animal, breaking the flea life cycle. The elimination of both adult fleas and flea eggs is important because adult fleas live on your pet, causing discomfort and skin irritation, while the vast number of eggs that they lay fall off and develop in your house. If fleas are already developing in your house, then also use {premise and yard products}. Effective flea control requires treatment of your pets, house, and yard.]

[Zoecon RF 9307 Pump Spray contains PRECOR® [vIGRen®] Insect Growth Regulator which effectively kills botfly eggs that have been glued to the hairs on the forelegs, shoulders, and faces of horses by adult botflies (*Gastrophilus* spp.). If left untreated, botfly larvae emerge from these eggs and are taken into the mouth of the horse. After botfly larvae are swallowed they attach to the stomach and small intestinal linings in tremendous numbers where they can remain for months before passing out in the feces. Adult botflies emerge from pupae in the soil to begin the cycle all over again. Botflies have been implicated as a cause of some stomach and intestinal conditions in horses.]

User Restrictions:

Do not apply more than one time per day.

Use Restrictions:

Do not apply to pets less than 12 weeks old.

Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, aged, pregnant, nursing or medicated animals. Sensitivities may occur after using ANY pesticide product for pets [animal]. If signs of sensitivity occur bathe your pet [animal] with mild soap and rinse with large amounts of water. If signs continue, consult a veterinarian immediately.

The maximum application rate for this product is once per week, applied at a rate of 0.13 fl oz per lb of body weight.

Dose is about 1 fl oz per 100 lb animal body weight. In all cases, apply spray until coat is damp, not saturated. Do not apply more than one time per day (horse use).

FOR DOGS/CATS:

For Fleas, Ticks, and Flea Eggs: A light, even coverage of the hair coat will provide effective flea control. Do not allow spray from application or damp animal to come into contact with painted or finished surfaces, including wood floors/furniture, leather/vinyl materials, or other surfaces of concern.

- 1. For best results, ruffle the coat while spraying against the natural lay of the hair. Cover pet's eyes with hand. With a firm, fast stroke, spray head, ears, and chest. If you see a tick, spray it directly.
- 2. With cloth, rub on face around mouth, nose, and eyes. Then spray the neck, middle and hind quarters, finishing with legs and tail last. Avoid spraying rectum and genitals.
- 3. For all pets, spray until damp, not saturated. Do not allow pets to become chilled.
- 4. If your pet becomes reinfested with adult fleas or ticks from outside sources, [ZOECON® 9307 Pump Spray] may be reapplied one week after the initial application. Repeat every month for continuous home flea infestation prevention.

Directed dosage: Note that the directed dose is about 4 squeezes of the trigger sprayer [0.13 fluid ounce] per pound of body weight. Short-haired pets will need less; more spray may be needed for long-haired pets. In all cases, apply spray until the coat is damp, not saturated.

For Mosquitoes: Apply as directed for fleas. For continuous protection against mosquitoes, reapply {Brand name] once weekly.

FOR PUPPIES/KITTENS:

For Fleas, Ticks, and Flea Eggs A light, even coverage of the hair coat will provide effective flea control. Do not allow spray from application or damp animal to come into contact with painted or finished surfaces, including wood floors/furniture, leather/vinyl materials, or other surfaces of concern. Leaving the eyes, nose, and mouth exposed, treat puppies/kittens weighing less than 3 lbs. by wrapping the animal in a towel which has been lightly sprayed with [Brand name]. Keep the animal wrapped for 5 to 10 minutes. Or lightly spray a brush or cotton ball and work thoroughly into the hair coat. Adult fleas may then be removed from the coat by picking or combing. Puppies/kittens over 3 lbs. may be treated the same as dogs/cats with [1 to 2 squeezes of the trigger sprayer][3 to 4 squeezes of the trigger sprayer][0.13 ounce] per pound of body weight. Reapply every 28 days [1 month], for continuous home flea infestation prevention. For continuous protection against adult fleas, or if your pet becomes reinfested with adult fleas from outside sources, reappy [Brand name] once weekly. Do not allow animal to become chilled.

IFOR HORSES AND PONIES:1

[For Mosquitoes, [Bot][Face] Flies, Gnats and Botfly Eggs: Remove excess dirt and dust by brushing the coat. Apply the spray once weekly directly to the horse's/pony's coat, paying particular attention to the legs, shoulders, flanks, neck and topline. Spray to the point of dampness, but not to the point of runoff. To treat the face, dampen a cloth with the spray and rub on the face and head, being careful to avoid the eyes. For a high degree of mosquito, fly, gnat, and botfly egg control, spray animals every 3 to 5 days. Do not use on horses destined for slaughter.]
