

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable subject to the comments listed below.

- 1. The product chemistry review completed during reregistration indicates that you may revise the signal word from "WARNING" to "CAUTION."
- 2. The acute toxicity review completed during reregistration indicates that you must re-order the FIRST AID statements. Revise the statement as follows

"FIRST AID:

IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor or going for treatment. You may also contact 1-800-248-7763 for emergency medical treatment information."

- 3. Revise the **HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS** statement as follows:

"CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Harmful if absorbed through skin. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin, or clothing. Wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet."

- 4. The **STORAGE AND DISPOSAL** statement must be enclosed in a box per the guidelines of 40 CFR 156.10(i)2(ix) and PR 83-3 as follows:

<p>STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:</p> <p>Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal</p> <p>Pesticide Storage: text here</p> <p>Pesticide Disposal: text here</p> <p>Container Handling: text here</p>

The **STORAGE AND DISPOSAL** statement must also be revised as follows:

"Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. In case of spill or leak, ventilate area well, then soak up with soil or other absorbent material.

Pesticide Storage: Store in a cool dry place. Always store pesticides in the original container. Keep pesticide storage areas clean. Storage areas must be locked and secure from vandalism, with precautionary signs posted. The storage area must be dry, well-lit, and well-ventilated. Keep pesticide storage areas clean. Clean up any spills promptly.”

“Pesticide Disposal: To avoid wastes, use all material in this container by formulation according to label directions. If wastes cannot be avoided, offer remaining product to a waste disposal facility or pesticide disposal program (often such programs are run by state or local governments or by industry).”

“Container Handling: Non-refillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into formulation equipment or a mix tank and drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Fill the container ¼ full with water and recap. Shake for 10 seconds. Pour rinsate into formulation equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Repeat this procedure two more times. Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.”

5. Revise the **WARRANTY STATEMENT** as follows:

Revise the statement to include ‘To the extent consistent with applicable law’, at the beginning of each sentence as follows:

- “To the extent consistent with applicable law, seller warrants that the chemical”
- “To the extent consistent with applicable law, seller makes no other warranty”
- “To the extent consistent with applicable law, buyer assumes all risks of use”

Two copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records. If you have any questions, you may contact Clayton T.
