## **DIRECTIONS FOR USE:**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

- Buckle collar around cat's neck. [Thread flat end of the collar through buckle hole and tighten as
  necessary, so that at least 2 ridges are covered by the buckle. Since the plastic buckle is molded
  into the collar, the possibility of neck irritation and buckle failure is reduced.] Fit collar snug enough
  to prevent placement of the cat's leg or lower jaw through the collar, yet loose enough to be rotated
  about the neck.
- 2. Leave 1-2 extra inches on the length of the collar for adjustment, cut off excess, and dispose of in trash.
- 3. Check periodically and adjust fit if necessary, especially when kittens are rapidly growing.
- 4. Replace in [245 days][35 weeks][8 months] or sooner if needed. Replace in [175 days][25 weeks][6 months] or sooner if needed. [To release the collar, squeeze buckle between thumb and finger and pull sharply.] Collar does not need replacement if cat becomes wet.
