The amended label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. This approval does not affect any conditions that were previously imposed on this registration. You continue to be subject to existing conditions on your registration and any deadlines connected with them.

A stamped copy of your labeling is enclosed for your records. This labeling supersedes all previously accepted labeling. You must submit one copy of the final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the new labeling. In accordance with 40 CFR 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell this product under the previously approved labeling for 18 months from the date of this letter. After 18 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR 152.3.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Therefore, should the Agency find or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA approved registration, the website will be referred to the EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance.

Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance

APPLICATION METHOD
















[Alternate applicator sizes permissible as long as dosage/ratios are maintained the same.

- 1. Bend at perforation and tear off first month's applicator.
- 2. Hold applicator [tube][and bend area of plastic at perforation, tear off and discard]. [Hold applicator] [tube] upright and snap tip back, away from face and body of person and dog. OR Hold applicator [tube] and bend numbered area of plastic at perforation, tear off and discard. Hold applicator [tube] upright away from face and body of person and dog, and use scissors to cut secure seal applicator tip.
- 3. Position the tip of the applicator [tube] on the dog's back between the shoulder blades. Apply ½ of the contents of the tube and proceed with step 4.
- 4. Invert the applicator [tube] to an upright position. Position the tip of the applicator [tube] at the base of the tail and apply the remaining contents of the [applicator] tube.
- 5. Do not reapply product for 30 days.

- 1. Bend at perforation and tear off first month's applicator.
- 2. Hold applicator and bend area of plastic at perforation, tear off and discard. Hold applicator upright and snap tip back, away from face and body of <u>person and dog</u>. OR Hold applicator and bend numbered area of plastic at perforation, tear off and discard. Hold applicator upright away from face and body of <u>person and dog</u>, and use scissors to cut secure seal applicator tip.
- 3. Position the tip of the applicator at the base of the dog's neck. Apply $\frac{1}{3}$ of the contents of the applicator.
- 4. Invert the applicator to an upright position and move to the middle of the dog's back. Apply ½ of the remaining contents of the applicator.
- 5. Invert the applicator to an upright position and move to the base of the dog's tail. Apply the remaining $\frac{1}{3}$ of the contents of the applicator.
- 6. Do not reapply product for 30 days.
