The Agency is in receipt of your Application for Pesticide Notification under Pesticide Registration Notice (PRN) 98-10. The Registration Division (RD) has conducted a review of this request for its applicability under PRN 98-10 and finds that the request is not acceptable for the following reasons:

- 1. The subject label includes a number of "reinfestation" marketing claims that need to be revised due to the presence of the insect growth regulator in the formulation.
- 2. You must incorporate all of the label revision provisions that have been noted on the attached marked up copy of the subject Notification label, and resubmit an amended master label as a label amendment for potential subsequent approval by the Agency.
