ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is extremely toxic to fish and aquatic invertebrates. To protect the environment, do not allow pesticide to enter or run off into storm drains, drainage ditches, gutters, or surface waters. Applying this product in calm weather when rain is not predicted for the next 24 hours will help to ensure that wind or rain does not blow or wash pesticide off the treatment area. Rinsing application equipment over the treated area will help avoid run off to water bodies or drainage systems. Drift from treated areas may be hazardous to organisms in adjacent aquatic sites.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

LAWN FLEA AND TICK CONTROL:

To kill fleas and ticks harboring in residential lawns and backyards, use this concentrate in a hose-end sprayer. Attach to sprayer and spray as recommended. For best results, lawn should be mowed a day or two before spraying. Spray using a slow, even sweeping motion, being sure to cover the entire lawn surface where the pets will normally frequent. Spray under ornamentals and trees, but avoid soaking young or flowering plants. Repeat treatments may be necessary at 7 to 14 day intervals. Kills on contact the *lxodes dammini* tick (deer tick), which transmits Lyme disease. Also kills foraging fire ants upon direct contact. A registered fire ant mound treatment should also be used in conjunction with this product. Keep pets and children out of the treated area until after the spray has dried. Do not spray animals. Dogs, cats, their kennel or bedding areas should also be treated with a registered flea and tick control product in conjunction with this application.

FOR OUTDOOR PESTS:

Mix concentrate in a compressed air sprayer or watering can at the rate of two (2) fluid ounces per one (1) gallon of water to control on contact ants, cockroaches, (including German and Asian cockroaches), crickets, palmetto bugs, sowbugs, spiders and ticks. Use at the rate of one (1) gallon (diluted spray) per 1,000 square feet to outside surfaces of buildings, porches, patios garages and other areas where these pests have been seen or are found. Do not spray in or near fish ponds or other bodies of water. Do not allow spray to contact ornamental plants or shrubs because of possible injury.

BUILDING PERIMETER TREATMENT:

To help prevent infestations of buildings by ants, centipedes, crickets, sowbugs, and spiders, treat a 12-18 inch band of soil or other substrate adjacent to buildings and the building foundation to a height of 2 to 3 feet where these pests are active and may find entrance. Use sixteen (16) fluid ounces of concentrate per gallon of water and apply as a coarse wet spray at the rate of one (1) gallon per 1,000 square feet.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place. Keep container closed.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL & CONTAINER HANDLING: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. **If empty:** Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. **If partially filled**: Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.

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DIRECTIONS FOR HOSE-END SPRAYER

The enclosed hose-end sprayer cap is calibrated to deliver the correct amount of Speer Yard Spray II. Use this hose-end sprayer cap only with the accompanying bottle of lawn spray in accordance with carton label directions.

To use Hose-end sprayer cap:

- 1. Check that valve is in OFF position.
- 2. Screw garden hose into back of spray cap (Note: end with black rubber washer).
- 3. Remove bottle cap from Speer Yard Spray II and save for storage after use.
- 4. Insert small end of dip tube into lawn spray bottle.
- 5. Screw lawn spray bottle counterclockwise into sprayer cap until tight.
- 6. Turn on water at faucet.
- 7. TO START FLOW OF INSECTICIDE, turn valve to ON position (see 1. above).
- 8. Spray evenly and completely over lawn and other infested areas giving particular attention to areas frequented by pets.
- 9. TO STOP FLOW OF INSECTICIDE at any time, simply turn valve to OFF position.

To store remaining insecticides, turn water off at faucet and remove insecticide bottle from sprayer. Leave dip tube in bottle and replace cap. Rinse off sprayer and store in accompanying box.
