The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the referenced product in connection with the MGK-264, Piperonyl butoxide, and Pyrethrins REDs and has concluded that your submission is acceptable.

NOTE: This product is not being reregistered under sections 3(c)5 and 4(g) of FIFRA at this time.

Please be reminded that 40 CFR Part 156.140(a)(4) requires that a batch code, lot number, or other code identifying the batch of the pesticide distributed and sold be placed on <u>non-refillable</u> containers. The code may appear either on the label or durably marked on the container itself, and can be added by non-notification per PRN 98-10.

Please note that the record for this product currently contains the Confidential Statements of Formulation (CSFs) listed below. Any previously dated CSFs are superseded.

A copy of your label stamped "Accepted" is enclosed along with copies of the acute toxicity and product chemistry reviews completed for the subject product. DIRECTIONS FOR USE

USE RESTRICTIONS:

The maximum application for pets is once per week. Horses and livestock may be treated once per day.

Apply wipes until pet fur is damp, but do not allow pet fur to become saturated. For horses and non-food livestock, do not apply more than 3 wipes per horse/pony/livestock per application. (For on-animal (pet) use)

Do not apply to pets less than 12 weeks old.

Consult a veterinarian before using this product on medicated, debilitated, aged, pregnant or nursing animals.

Sensitivities may occur after using ANY pesticide product for pets. If signs of sensitivity occur, bathe your pet with mild soap and rinse with large amounts of water. If signs continue, consult a veterinarian immediately.

CAP THREADING INSTRUCTIONS: Remove entire cap from container. Locate the first wipe in the center of roll. Thread wipe through center of cap. Place cap firmly back onto container. Pull wipe up to release.

FOIL POUCH INSTRUCTIONS (multiple towelette packages): Tear corner of outside pouch, exposing resealable inner pouch. Pull edges of inner pouch apart to expose towelette. Remove towelette from inner pouch, then reseal pouch immediately to preserve product quality. FOIL POUCH INSTRUCTIONS (individual towelette packages): Tear corner of pouch. Remove towelette and dispose of pouch in trash.

ON ANIMALS: To protect animals from horn flies, house flies, mosquitoes, fleas, ticks, mites, deer ticks and gnats: First brush animal to remove excess dirt and dust. Apply a light coating sufficient to wet the tips of the hair. Do not apply to animal's genitalia or get in eyes. To control stable flies, horse flies and deer flies: Apply sufficient to wet the hair, but not to soak the hide. Recommended for use on face and around eyes and ears. Reapply every week to give continued protection. Wash hands thoroughly after application.
