Close outside doors and windows and shut off fans and air conditioning to maximize killing power of fog. Remove pets, birds, and tightly cover or remove fish bowls and aquariums before spraying. Cover waxed wood floors and waxed furniture in the immediate area surrounding the fogger (newspapers may be used). (EPA PRE-APPROVED PICTOGRAM 5 REPESENTING -) Remove or cover exposed foods, dishes, utensils or food handling equipment. Cover all food processing surfaces during treatment or thoroughly clean before using. AIRING OUT
