The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all the information submitted with your application to support the Registration Review of the above referenced product in connection with the Permethrin Interim Decision, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable. The label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable.

#### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

#### **USE RESTRICTIONS**

Do not allow adults, children, or pets to enter the treated area until sprays have dried or until vapors, mists, and aerosols have dispersed, and the treated area has been thoroughly ventilated. Do not remain in treated area. Exit area immediately and remain outside the treated area until aerosols have dispersed.

Do not wet articles to point of runoff or drip. Do not use treated article until spray has dried. Dry clean treated clothes before wearing.

Do not wet plants to point of runoff or drip.

Remove or cover exposed food and drinking water before application. Remove or cover dishes, utensils, food processing equipment, and food preparation surfaces, or wash them before use. All outdoor spray applications must be limited to spot or crack-and-crevice treatments only, except for the following permitted uses

Application to pervious surfaces such as soil, lawn, turf, and other vegetation;

- Spot treatments must not exceed two square feet in size (for example, 2 ft. by 1 ft. or 4 ft. by 0.5 ft.).
- For soil or foliar applications, do not apply by ground within 25 feet of lakes, reservoirs, rivers, permanent streams, marshes or natural ponds, estuaries and commercial fish farm ponds.
- Do not apply the product into fish pools, ponds, streams, or lakes. Do not apply directly to sewers or storm drains, or to any area like a drain or gutter where drainage to sewers, storm drains, water bodies, or aquatic habitat can occur.
- Do not allow the product to enter any drain during or after application.
- Do not apply directly to impervious horizontal surfaces such as sidewalks, driveways, and patios except as a spot or crack-and-crevice treatment.
- Treat surfaces to ensure thorough coverage but avoid runoff.
- To treat insects harbored in voids and cracks-and-crevices, applications must be made in such a manner to limit dripping and avoid runoff onto untreated structural surfaces and plants.
- Do not apply or irrigate to the point of run-off. Do not make applications during rain.
   Avoid making applications when rainfall is expected before the product has sufficient time to dry (minimum 4 hours). Rainfall within 24 hours after application may cause unintended runoff of pesticide application.

For surfaces, to apply at the maximum rate, spray for about 24 seconds to cover an area of 100 sq ft (10' X 10'). As a space spray, to apply at the maximum rate, spray for about 20 seconds to cover an area of 1000 cu ft (10' X 12.5' with an 8' ceiling).

Do not use in rooms/areas while occupied by patients, the elderly or infirm.

Do not apply this product in a way that will contact adults, children, or pets, either directly or through drift. Remove pets and birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

Not for broadcast use on indoor surfaces

Do not allow the product to enter indoor or outdoor drains unless labeled for drain treatments. #### SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

For indoor and outdoor use. Remove protective cap, hold container upright and spray from a distance of 12 to 15 inches.

INDOORS:Cluster Flies, House flies, Fruit Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Black Flies, Skipper Flies, Blow Flies and Small Flying Moths: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room, moving toward the door. Direct spray to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Keep nozzle in constant motion. Sweep up and discard fallen insects.

Cockroaches, Waterbugs, Palmetto Bugs, Silverfish, Firebrats, Crickets, Scorpions, Spiders (except black widow, brown recluse and hobo), Millipedes, Sowbugs and Pillbugs: Spray into hiding places such as cracks and crevices, behind sinks, cabinets, along baseboards and floors, around drains and plumbing, hitting insects with spray whenever possible.

**Ants:** Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. **Carpet Beetles:** Spray directly on beetles, floors, baseboards, shelves and carpets. **Bed bugs:** Spray mattresses, particularly around tufts and seams. Take beds apart and spray into all joints. Treat baseboards, moldings and floors.

**TO Kill Clothes Moths and Carpet Beetles** on wool and other proteinaceous fibers: Remove infested articles from storage, brush thoroughly, and air for several hours in sunlight, if possible. Apply spray liberally to empty chests, closets, bureaus and other storages directing the spray into cracks, joints and crevices. After airing, infested articles may be treated by spraying lightly, keeping nozzle at least three feet from fabric to avoid staining.

**Fleas in buildings - Space spray:** Hold can 36 inches above floor and direct spray toward floor and lower walls at a rate of 10 seconds per 100 sq. ft. making sure that all floor, sofa and chair surfaces are contacted. Repeat treatment after 7 days

**Fleas & Ticks (Adults and Larvae):** Remove and thoroughly clean or destroy pet bedding. Spray pet sleeping quarters, bed, entire floor and floor covering, with special attention to cracks and crevices around baseboards, and window and door frames. Infested upholstered furniture and mattresses may also be treated with this product. Make a test application to upholstery or drapery fabrics in an inconspicuous place before use.

#### **OUTDOORS:**

Point spray nozzle away from face. Hold can on slight downward angle. For best results, spray when air is calm. Allow a few minutes for product to take effect. Spray with wind if breeze is blowing. Do not use on edible crops.

**FLYING INSECTS:** Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Small Flying Moths,: Allow fog to drift over area. Direct spray toward bushes, or grass from at least 4 to 6 feet away. Give special attention to breeding areas such as garbage cans and compost piles.

**CRAWLING INSECTS:** Ants, Cockroaches, including Asian Cockroaches, Crickets, Mole Crickets, and Silverfish: Spray infested surface of patio or picnic area, hitting as many insects as possible. Also spray legs of tables and chairs to repel ants. Spray ant hills for best control.

**TO KILL GARDEN INSECTS:** For use on roses, dahlias, asters and other ornamentals to kill **Japanese Beetles** hit by spray, as well as **Whiteflies, Aphids, exposed Thrips, Spiders** (except black widow, brown recluse and hobo), **Red Mites and Leafminers**. May be used on plants such as African violets, asters, azaleas, begonias, camellias, carnations, chrysanthemums, dahlias, delphiniums, dogwood, English ivy, euonymus, fuschia, geraniums, crassula, grape vine, Kentia palm, laurel, marigolds, rhododendrons, roses, rubber plants, snapdragons, stocks, wandering Jews and zinnias. Not for use on plants being grown for sale or other commercial use.

Effective when used as directed against Whiteflies, Aphids, Spiders (except black widow, brown recluse and hobo), and Red Mites, exposed Thrips, Lace Bugs, Japanese Beetles, Pavement Ants, Clover Mites and Army Worms. When spraying plants do not operate closer than 18 inches. Use sweeping motion. Spray in one second bursts. Be cautious about wetting tender foliage, young plants and new growth. Do not spray plants when temperatures exceed 90° F. Contact insects directly whenever possible. Repeat treatment as infestations occur.

**STORAGE:** Store in cool, dry area.
