The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with the following label revision provision(s):

Precautionary Statements, Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals subsection comment(s), top of page 2 of 5:

 Insert the following text immediately preceding the existing 1st sentence within this subsection: "Harmful if swallowed."

Precautionary Statements, First Aid subsection comment(s), middle of page 2 of 5:

 Revise the 2nd sentence of the HOT LINE NUMBER statement to read "For additional information on this product (including health concerns, medical emergencies or pesticide incidents), you may call 1-800-xxx-xxxx, twenty-four (24) hours per day, seven (7) days per week."

Directions for Use, USE RESTRICTIONS subsection comment(s), bottom of page 3 of 5:

3. Within the 9th bulleted statement, capitalize the letter "o" at the beginning of the 2nd sentence.

Storage and Disposal Statement section comment(s), page 5 of 5:

4. Revise the "DISPOSAL:" subsection heading to read "CONTAINER DISPOSAL:"

USE INFORMATION: Premium Roach Spray provides effective kill of listed pests in and on buildings, structures and their immediate surroundings and on modes of transport. Permitted areas of use: (apartment buildings, homes, hospitals, and the non-food/feed areas of hotels, industrial buildings, laboratories, mausoleums, motels, nursing homes, private residences, schools, stores, utilities warehouses, and in non-food areas of [restaurants, food manufacturing, processing, and servicing establishments], and on: vessels, rail cars, aircraft (do not use in aircraft cabins), buses, trucks and trailers).

INDOORS

Hold container upright with nozzle away from you. Press valve down and spray surface until slightly wet (at a rate of 2 seconds to treat approximately 1 linear foot of baseboard area).

To kill Cockroaches, Ants, Crickets, Earwigs, Firebrats, Fleas, Silverfish, Spiders, and Sowbugs: Apply as a crack and crevice or spot treatment to areas where these pests crawl and hide, especially on hidden surfaces around sinks and storage areas, along and behind baseboards, around doors and windows, behind and under refrigerators, cabinets, sinks and stoves, and on the underside of shelves, drawers and bookcases. **Do not reapply more often thar**, every **14 days**. Ants: Spray around ant trails, doors and windows and other places where ants enter premises. Fleas in Buildings: Remove and destroy pet's old bedding and replace with clean fresh bedding after treatment of pet areas. Apply as a crack and crevice treatment to infested areas such as pet beds, sleeping quarters of pets, around base boards, windows and door frames, local areas of floors (under the edges of rugs and floor coverings), and between/under cushions of upholstered furniture. As a broadcast application for fleas, spray at the maximum rate of 24 seconds to cover an area of 5' X 10' (50 sq ft). Do not allow pets to reoccupy treated areas until treated surfaces have thoroughly dried. DO NOT USE THIS PRODUCT DIRECTLY ON DOMESTIC/COMPANION ANIMALS (DOGS, CATS, PUPPIES OR KITTENS). Treat dogs and cats with a flea and tick control product before allowing them to reenter the treated area.

Spiders: Apply as a crack and crevice or spot treatment along and behind baseboards, to window and door frames, corners, pipes, storage localities, attics, crawl spaces and other areas over which these pests may crawl.

Earwigs, Mole Crickets, Pillbugs, and Sowbugs: Apply as a crack and crevice or spot treatment around doors and windows, along and behind baseboards, and in storage areas where these pests are found.

Pantry Pests - Exposed Stages of Sawtoothed Grain Beetles, Flour Beetles (Red and Confused), and Cigarette Beetles: Treat exposed stages. Remove all foodstuffs, utensils and shelf paper from area to be treated. Discard used shelf paper and any infested foodstuffs. Apply spray to shelves and in cracks and crevices behind and under cupboards and cabinets. Allow spray to dry prior to replacement of shelf paper, food and utensils.

Carpet Beetles (Black, Furniture and Varied): Apply as a crack and crevice or spot treatment on and under edges of floor coverings, under rugs and furniture and in closets or other localities where these insects are found.

Bed Bugs – Thoroughly inspect area of suspected bed bug infestation and note potential harborage sites or actual infestations. Remove and/or pick up clothing and other obstacles that may prevent thorough inspection or treatment. Remove and sanitize infested bedding (pillows and linens), clothing or other items.

Apply [brand name] on mattresses as a spot treatment to mattress seams, edges, and tufts of bed only. Do not use [brand name] directly on mattresses, pillows, bed linens or clothes. Do not saturate the mattress; and do not treat entire surface area of mattress. Allow mattress to dry thoroughly before replacing pillows and/or bed linens.

Apply as a spray to outside surfaces of buildings where listed insects tend to congregate. Spray areas include screens, window frames, eaves, porches, patios, garages and refuse dumps.
