The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable with the following label revision provisions:

1. Revise the Storage and Disposal Statement on page 4 in accordance with PR Notice 2007-4, adding the following statement: "Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal."
2. Revise the Warranty Statement on page 4 as follows. "To the extent consistent with applicable law, buyer assumes all risks of use, storage or handling of this material not in strict accordance with directions given herewith."

You must submit two copies of the final printed label revised in accordance with the comments listed above before the product is released for shipment under this label. **Note:** Do not apply to classrooms when in use. Do not use in aircraft cabins. Do not apply to patient rooms in hospitals and nursing homes while occupied. For use in the non-food and non-feed areas of food and feed handling establishments. Do not use in food or feed areas of food or feed handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food or feed is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or the facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served, such as dining rooms but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held. **TO USE THIS PRODUCT CORRECTLY**

(EPA PRE-APPROVED PICTOGRAM 1 REPRESENTING - ) DO NOT use MULTIPLE foggers per room. (EPA PRE-APPROVED PICTOGRAM 2 REPRESENTING - ) DO NOT use in small confined spaces such as closets, cabinets or under counter or tables. USE OF A FOGGER IN AN ENCLOSED SPACE MAY CAUSE THE PRODUCT TO EXPLODE, RESULTING IN INJURY TO PEOPLE OR DAMAGE TO PROPERTY. Do not use in a room 5 ft. x 5 ft. or smaller; instead, allow fogs to enter from other rooms. **BEFORE YOU FOG**

Open interior doors and closets of area to be treated. Open all cupboards and drawers and remove contents. (EPA PRE-APPROVED PICTOGRAM 5 REPRESENTING - ) Cover or remove exposed food. Cover all food processing surfaces and utensils during treatment or thoroughly wash before reuse. Remove pets and birds. Tightly cover fish aquariums. Close outside doors and windows and turn off fans and air conditioners.

**NOTE:** Asphalt tile and some plastics may be affected by this product. Place newspaper on asphalt tile before treatment and cover plastic items such as plastic furniture, stereo covers, eye glasses, etc.

**TO START FOGGING**

**SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE.**

Place can in the middle of the room, on a stand, table, chair or on the floor. Place several layers of unfolded newspaper, covering a 2 sq. ft. area directly under can to prevent marring of surface. Keeping at arm's length, point top of can away from face and press down actuator tab to lock into position and release fogging action. Set can in an upright position and leave treated area for at least two hours. Also, remove pets and keep out of treated area for at least 2 hours. Repeat treatments to infested areas as necessary at intervals of 14 days or greater. Do not make more than 6 applications per site per year. **Vacate the treated house, individual apartment unit, or other structure immediately.** Use enclosed Door Hang Tag to mark the time when re-entry is permitted (at least two hours after the start time). Fill out and place hang tag on the door to the treated area to alert family and others with access to the treated area not to enter for 2 hours
