

- 2. Set fogger in an upright position on chair or table covered with newspapers or paper towels and leave premises immediately
- 3. Vacate the treated house, individual apartment unit, or other structure immediately. KEEP TREATED AREA CLOSED. DO NOT RE-ENTER FOR AT LEAST TWO HOURS. Keeping treated area sealed for a longer period will enhance fogger performance. Use enclosed Door Hang Tag to mark the time when re-entry is permitted (at least two hours after the start time).
