Dear Ms. Huebl:

The amended label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. This approval does not affect any conditions that were previously imposed on this registration. You continue to be subject to existing conditions on your registration and any deadlines connected with them.

A stamped copy of your labeling is enclosed for your records. This labeling supersedes all previously accepted labeling. You must submit one copy of the final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the new labeling. In accordance with 40 CFR 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell this product under the previously approved labeling for 18 months from the date of this letter. After 18 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR 152.3.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Therefore, should the Agency find or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA approved registration, the website will be referred to the EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance.

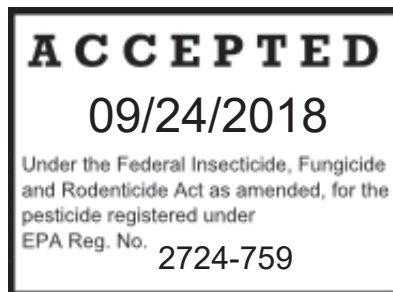

To prevent reoccurrence of fleas, a total management program is recommended. You should treat the areas where fleas live with the HOLIDAY® 4 -Step Program which consists of: Step 1 - Shampoo/Dip the Pet; Step 2 - Treat the Home and Yard; Step 3 - Flea and Tick Collars on the Pet; Step 4 - Maintenance Sprays and Powders. As a result, tangles brush out easily, leaving the pet with a clean, soft, shiny, healthier-looking coat and a fresh, clean smell. [For added protection against fleas and ticks, use [brand name] Flea & Tick Dip and Spray as part of pet grooming.] As with any quality product, be sure to read all label instructions carefully.]

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

WARNING

Causes substantial but temporary eye injury or skin irritation. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or safety glasses. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

While washing dogs, cats, kittens or puppies, avoid getting shampoo in animal's eyes. **Do not use on kittens or puppies under 6 months of age. Do not use on kittens or puppies weighing less than 5 pounds.** Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, aged, pregnant or nursing animals, or animals on medication.

Applicators of flea shampoo products are to use protective gloves to reduce the risk of dermal irritation or dermal sensitization.

Sensitivities may occur after using ANY pesticide product for pets. If signs of sensitivity occur bathe your pet with mild soap and rinse with large amounts of water. If signs continue, consult a veterinarian immediately. Individual animals may exhibit one or more of the following symptoms: hypothermia, tremors, ataxia, excess salivation, agitation and vocalization followed by lethargic behavior, skin and eye irritation in varying degrees. DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Wet dog, cat, puppy or kitten with warm water and apply small amount of shampoo along the back of the animal. Work well into coat, starting at head and working back. Include legs and feet. When lather is of desired consistency, continue to work into coat for 10 minutes to kill fleas. Rinse thoroughly with warm water and dry. When washing cats, kittens or puppies, dry with cloth immediately after rinsing to prevent chilling. **Do not use on kittens or puppies under 6 months of age. Do not use on kittens or puppies weighing less than 5 pounds.** Do not reapply product for one week.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Keep this product in its tightly closed original container. Store in a cool, dry (preferably locked) area away from children or pets.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL AND CONTAINER HANDLING: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. **If empty:** Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. **If partly filled:** Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
