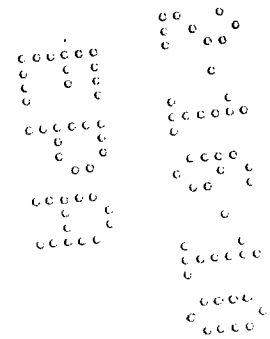
Enclosed is a completed EPA Form 8570-1 and 1 copy of a highlighted label (new text is red, blue strikethrough is deleted text) per PRN 2007-4 and 83-3. The text represents exact text from the PR Notices. When revising the container handling for 2007-4, it was realized that the previous Storage/Disposal text revised by Speer reflected the product as a consumer/household product. This emulsifiable concentrate is a product that is applied in households by certified pesticide applicators (Terminix). It is not marketed to nor for use by consumers. Therefore, per PRN 83-3, the Pesticide Disposal was revised with text from the PR Notice and the general statement was added "Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal" (also per PRN 83-3). Additionally, the registrant information was brought up-to-date to reflect Speer transfer (3/23/06) to Wellmark.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Use at a rate of 3 fluid ounces per gallon for each 1000 square feet. For control of fleas, thoroughly apply a fine particle broadcast spray, using 3 ounces per gallon of water to infested rugs, carpets, pet resting areas, under cushions of furniture, cracks or crevices (non-food areas), and around baseboards. Old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. **Do not spray pet with this product. Do not use full strength.** For light infestation of fleas - Use at a rate of 2 ounces per gallon of water for each 1,000 square feet.

**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS**

This product is toxic to fish. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of waste.

**PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS**

Do not use or store near heat or open flame.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

**Storage:** Store in a cool, dry place. Keep container closed.

**Pesticide Disposal:** Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. **Container Handling:** Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Clean container promptly after emptying. Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank and drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Fill the container 1/4 full with water and recap. Shake for 10 seconds. Pour rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Repeat this procedure two more times.

Then offer for recycling if available or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

**Disposal: If empty:** Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. **If partly filled:** Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.

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
