The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the above referenced product in connection with the Pyrethrins, MGK-264, and Piperonyl Butoxide REDs; and has concluded that your submission is acceptable.

NOTE: This product is not being reregistered under sections 3(c)5 and 4(g) of FIFRA at this time.

Please be reminded that 40 CFR Part 156.140(a)(4) requires that a batch code, lot number, or other code identifying the batch of the pesticide distributed and sold be placed on non-refillable containers. The code may appear either on the label or durably marked on the container itself, and can be added by non-notification per PRN 98-10.

Please also note that the record for this product currently contains the Confidential Statements of Formulation (CSFs) listed below. Any previously dated CSFs are superseded.

- Basic CSF, dated June 29, 2011

A copy of your label stamped "Accepted" is enclosed along with copies of the acute toxicity and product chemistry reviews completed for the subject product. HOW RF2062 WORKS:

RF2062 kills ticks, mosquitoes, gnats, fleas, house flies, stable flies, horn flies, and face flies.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Precautions and Use Restrictions

- Apply this product only as specified on this label.
- For indoor use only
- Do not wet to point of runoff or drip.
- Do not use this product on horses destined for slaughter.
- For Dogs/Cats - The maximum application rate for this product is once per week, applied at a rate of 0.13 fl oz per lb of body weight.
- For Horses/Ponies - Dose is about 1 fl oz per 100 lb animal body weight. In all cases, apply spray until coat is damp, not saturated. Do not apply more than one time per day (for horses).
- Except when applied to pets as directed on this label, do not allow adults, children or pets to enter treated areas until sprays have dried.
- Except when applied to pets as directed on this label, do not apply this product in a way that will contact adults, children, or pets, either directly or through drift.
- Except when applied to pets as directed on this label, remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before use.
- Not for broadcast use on indoor residential surfaces.
- Do not wet articles to point of runoff or drip. Do not use treated article until spray has dried.
- Do not apply when food is present. Remove or cover exposed food and drinking water before application. Remove or cover dishes, utensils, food processing equipment, and food preparation surfaces during treatment or wash them thoroughly before use.
- Application is prohibited directly into sewers or drains, or to any area like a gutter where drainage to sewers, storm drains, water bodies, or aquatic habitat can occur. Do not allow the product to enter any drain during or after application.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING. Use only in a well ventilated area.

FOR DOGS AND CATS

For Fleas and Ticks: A light, even coverage of the hair coat will provide effective flea control. Do not allow spray from application or damp animal to come into contact with painted or finished surfaces, including wood floors/furniture, leather/vinyl materials, or other surfaces of concern.

For best results, ruffle the coat while spraying against the natural lay of the hair. Cover pet's eyes with hand. With a firm, fast stroke, spray head, ears, and chest. If you see a tick, spray it directly.

1. With cloth, rub on face around mouth, nose, and eyes. Then spray the neck, middle and hind quarters, finishing with legs and tail last. Avoid spraying rectum and genitals.
2. For all pets, spray until damp, not saturated. Do not allow pets to become chilled.
3. If your pet becomes reinfested with adult fleas or ticks from outside sources, [Brand Name] may be reapplied one week after the initial application. Repeat every month for continuous home flea infestation prevention.

Application Rate: Note that the dose is about 4 squeezes of the trigger sprayer [0.13 fluid ounce] per pound of body weight. Short-haired pets will need less; more spray may be needed for long-haired pets. In all cases, apply spray until the coat is damp, not saturated.

FOR PUPPIES AND KITTENS

For Fleas and Ticks:

Do not apply to puppies/kittens less than 12 weeks of age. Leaving the eyes, nose, and mouth exposed, treat puppies and kittens weighing less than 3 pounds by wrapping the animal in a towel that has been lightly sprayed with [Brand Name], for 5 to 10 minutes. Or lightly spray a brush or cotton ball and work thoroughly into the hair coat. Fleas may then be removed from the coat by picking or combing. Puppies and kittens over 3 pounds may be treated the same as dogs and cats as described above. [Brand Name] may be reapplied weekly, if necessary. Do not allow animal to become chilled.

Except when applying directly to pets, do not apply this product in a way that will contact adults children, or pets ,either directly or through drift. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before surface spraying application .

FOR PET'S SLEEPING QUARTERS

The pet's bedding should be sprayed, making sure the area beneath the bedding is also sprayed. Do not allow spray from application to come into contact with painted or finished surfaces, including wood floors/furniture, leather/vinyl materials, or other surfaces of concern. After spray has dried, remove old pet bedding and replace with fresh bedding. Do not allow pets to reoccupy sleeping quarters until treated surfaces have thoroughly dried. Treat pets with [Brand Name] flea and tick control products before allowing pets to enter treated areas. Repeat weekly, if necessary.

[FOR HORSES AND PONIES

For Flies: To kill stable flies, horse flies, deer flies, and face flies, first remove excess dirt and dust by brushing coat. Apply spray to legs, shoulders, flanks, neck, top line and other body areas commonly attacked by these flies. Do not spray to the point of runoff. To treat face, dampen a cloth with spray and rub on face and head, being careful to avoid eyes.

STORAGE and DISPOSAL: Do not transfer contents to other containers. **Pesticide Storage:** Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame. Store away from children and animals. **Pesticide/Container Disposal:** Nonrefillable container. **If empty:** Do not reuse or refill this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. **If partially filled:** Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
