On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(a) provided that:

- 1. The basic Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) dated June 17, 2010 is the basic CSF of record and supersedes all previously accepted CSFs.
- 2. Make the following changes to the label:
 - a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read: "EPA Registration No. 2724-809".
 - b. Change "Controls reinfestation..." to "Controls flea reinfestation..."
 - c. Remove "Carpet penetrating formula that doesn't leave pests a place to hide."
 - d. The word "NEW" can only appear on this label during the first six months of sale.
 - e. Change: "THIS PRODUCT IS NOT USE ON HUMANS." to "THIS PRODUCT IS NOT FOR USE ON HUMANS OR PETS."
 - f. Remove the statement: "For best results, treat pets before they return to the treated areas."

 This statement is confusing and may lead some users to spray their pets.
 - g. Change "Results when you nee it." to "Results when you need them."
- 3. All of the product chemistry data requirements for this product have been satisfied, except for OCSPP Guidelines 830.6317 and 830.6320, Storage Stability and Corrosion Characteristics studies, respectively. Within one-year of the date of this registration you must submit these data

including interim reports made at 0, 3, 6, 9, and 12 month intervals.

- 4. You must submit and/or cite all data required for registration of your product under FIFRA Section 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data, and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4. EPA published the notice of availability of the MGK 264 RED in the Federal Register on July 26, 2006 (Vol. 71, No. 143, Pgs 42382-83). As a result, additional data and/or labeling changes may be required for products containing MGK 264.

It contains an Insect Growth Regulator (IGR) along with other ingredients to kill the adult fleas and prevent flea larvae from developing into biting adults. Reaches the hiding places of the flea: rugs, carpets, drapes, pet bedding, upholstery and furniture. Protects the household from a buildup of fleas and reinfestation. One treatment protects for 210 days [7 months][30 weeks]. For best results, use [Brand Name] spray together with other [Brand Name] products for complete control of fleas and ticks.

Remove or cover dishes, utensils, food processing equipment, and food preparation surfaces, or wash them before use.

To apply at the maximum rate, spray for 12 seconds to cover a 5 ft X 10 ft area

Do not apply this product in a way that will contact adults, children, or pets either directly or through drift. Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

Indoors: Thoroughly vacuum all carpeting, upholstered furniture, along baseboards, under furniture, and in closets. Seal vacuum bag and dispose of in trash outdoors. One can (16 oz) treats XXX (1000) square feet. Remove protective cap. Make a test application to upholstery or drapery fabrics in an inconspicuous place before use. Spray RF2104 Carpet Spray M [Brand Name] from 2 feet to 3 feet away from surface being treated. Apply with a smooth back-and-forth motion to carpets, drapes, rugs, and upholstered furniture. A fine mist spray that is evenly applied will do the job properly. Do not spray wood furniture, floors, or trim as water spotting may occur. Repeat treatment as necessary to control fleas and ticks.

Apply directly to exposed insects - roaches, ants, spiders, crickets, waterbugs, silverfish, sowbugs, and carpet beetles: Spray areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets, cracks and crevices, along baseboards and door sills and frames, behind sinks, stoves, refrigerators, and cabinets, and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Directly spray pests driven out of hiding places. Spray ant trails, nests, and points of entry. Repeat as necessary.

On Pet Bedding: Treat pet bedding and resting places. Apply a uniform application of RF2104 Carpet Spray M [Brand Name] to nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door sills, and localized areas of floors where fleas or ticks may be present as these are primary hiding places for fleas. Pet bedding does not need to be removed after treatment. For best results, treat pets before they return to the treated areas.

Indoor Kennels:

REMOVE PETS BEFORE SPRAYING.

Spray RF2104 Carpet Spray M [Brand Name] from 2 feet to 3 feet away from surface being treated. Apply with a smooth back-and-forth motion.
