Consistent with the guidance on [Pet Spot-On Enhanced Reporting Implementation \(updated Aug. 2019\)](#), the Agency has reviewed your request to remove the two-year registration expiration date and has found your company to be in compliance with the terms and conditions for the subject product. The accepted label dated 03/11/2022 contains appropriate mitigation measures. Further, the Agency has reviewed a sample of enhanced reporting using EPA's standardized templates, as described in Condition 3. hereafter, and concluded that the use of the standardized templates for enhanced reporting for this product will considerably improve pharmacovigilance and thus the continued safety of this product. Therefore, the Agency is removing the two-year registration expiration date for this product. The product remains subject to all other previously required conditions of registration, including the submission of enhanced incident reports and sales information as stated in the initial registration notice dated 10/11/2011 and amended below to require continued use of the standardized templates.
3. The Agency has reviewed your request to change the terms of your registration from quarterly to annual submission of enhanced incident and sales reports using EPA's standardized templates. Based on an initial screening of sample enhanced reports, the sample submission was determined to be adequate and the templates were successfully used. Therefore, the condition of quarterly submission of enhanced incident and sales reports is hereby amended to annual submission with continued use of these standardized templates. You must submit enhanced incident and sales reports for this product to the Agency every 12 months from the date the product is first released for shipment, or from the end date in the last quarterly enhanced reporting submission. The initial released-for-shipment date must be provided to the Product Manager, once known. 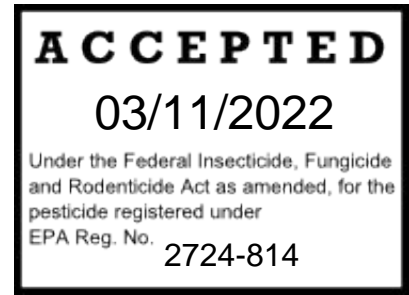
