Do not use from damaged, punctured or unsealed containers. End-use products formulated with this product must be registered by the US EPA.

FOR USE IN MANUFACTURING INSECT TRAPS AND LURES:

The active ingredient in this product may be used in fly traps and lures as long as the active ingredient is the sole ingredient in the trap or lure. When pheromones are used as the sole ingredient in accordance with 40 CFR 152.25(b), no registration requirements are needed under FIFRA.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. **Pesticide Storage:** Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area away from humans, pets, foodstuffs, or feed. Do not store near heat or open flame. Avoid contact with high temperatures, acids, bases, or prolonged contact with air. Absorb spilled material in dry, inert material.

Shake for 10 seconds. Pour rinsate into equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later disposal. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Repeat this procedure two more times. Then offer for recycling if available or reconditioning if appropriate, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.
