Dear Noelle Sanfilippo:

The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the Registration Review of the above referenced product in connection with the Propoxur Interim Decision, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable. The Agency also completed review of your amended label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, and has determined the label is also acceptable.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Therefore, should the Agency find or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA approved registration, the website will be referred to the EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance Assurance.

A stamped copy of your labeling is enclosed for your records. This labeling supersedes all previously accepted labeling and must be used at your next label printing. You must submit one copy of the final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the new labeling. In accordance with 40 CFR 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell this product under the previously approved labeling for 12 months from the date of this letter. After 12 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR 152.3.

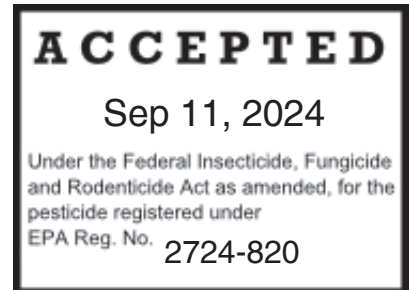

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

WARNING

May be fatal if swallowed. Harmful if inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Wear chemical resistant gloves, protective clothing, and goggles. In case of contact, wash immediately with soap and warm water. Wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse.

IF IN EYES:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes.▪ Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye.▪ Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: ANTIDOTE: Administer atropine sulfate in large therapeutic doses. Repeat as necessary to the point of tolerance. Compound inhibits cholinesterase resulting in stimulation of the central nervous system, the parasympathetic nervous system, and the somatic motor nerves. Do not give morphine. Watch for pulmonary edema, which may develop in serious cases of poisoning, even after 12 hours. At first sign of pulmonary edema, the patient should be placed in an oxygen tent and treated symptomatically.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish and wildlife. Keep out of lakes, streams, or ponds. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Not for formulation into aerosol or liquid products for indoor use.

Not for formulation into loose granular products.

Only for formulation into an insecticide,

(1) For the following uses:

Indoor use: all commercial indoor non-food and institutional use areas.

Outdoor uses restricted to (a) residential and commercial applications to surfaces of buildings, and (b) around patios, driveways, sidewalks, and foundations.

(2) Uses for which U.S. EPA has accepted the required data and/or citations of data that the formulator has submitted in support of registration.

(3) Uses for experimental purposes that are in compliance with U.S. EPA requirements. This product must not be used to manufacture or formulate any pesticide product which is distributed or sold with a trigger-type sprayer, or to manufacture or formulate any manufacturing use or other pesticide product which is intended or may be lawfully used to manufacture or formulate any pesticide product which is distributed or sold with a trigger-type sprayer.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal or cleaning of equipment.

Pesticide Storage: Store in a cool, dry place and in such a manner as to prevent cross contamination with other pesticides, fertilizers, food, and feed. Store in original container and out of the reach of children, preferably in a locked storage area.
