LAUNDRY — (For Washing: add four tablespoonfuls of Breath O' Pine to average tub or washing machine of soapy water.) Instantly releases dirt, reduces wear and minimizes work. Will not bleach. Safe for finest colored fabrics.

NURSERY — Clean and disinfect crib, toilet seat, nursery furniture, etc. Use 1 part to 20 parts water.
BATHROOM AND KITCHEN AND LINOLEUM (But not Asphalt, Vinyl, Composition or Rubber Tile) — 2 tablespoonfuls to one quart of soapy water.

TOILETS — Use full strength in bowl or tank to clean and deodorize.

HOUSEHOLD PESTS — To aid in repelling roaches and ants, apply full strength in all cracks, crevices and breeding places. Repeat treatment if necessary.

DOGS — Add 3 tablespoonfuls to one quart of water for washing dogs and elimination of doggy odor. Spray kennel with same solution.

PAINT BRUSHES — Soak full strength, rinse in clear water.

CAR WASH — 1/4 cup to gallon of water, rinse with clear water. Keep car out of sun.

DISINFECTS

GENERAL DISINFECTANT — Use 1 part to 20 parts water when disinfecting walls, floors, etc. — thoroughly wet all surfaces with required solution. Will not stain. Leaves a clean piney odor.

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Do not get in eyes. Do not contaminate foods. Antidote: If swallowed do not induce vomiting. Drink milk, egg white or gruel and call a physician.

Active Ingredients: Pine Oil 40%, Neutral Soap 15%, Isopropyl Alcohol 5%
