NOTE: 2-P/II is also anti-

poisonous if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Do not breathe spray mist. Use with adequate ventilation and wear using, wear protective clothing, gloves, mask and goggles. Avoid contact with eyes, skin, nose and throat. In case of contact, wash thoroughly with copious water. Wash contaminated clothing with soap and water before reuse.

If eyes are contacted, flush with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes.

In case of poisoning, call a physician immediately. Symptoms of poisoning are: "stinging" in the chest, stomach pains, contracted pupils, sweating, vomiting and diarrhea. If swallowed, call a physician immediately then let patient lie down and induce vomiting by giving 1 tablespoonful of salt in a glass of warm water. Keep inducing vomiting until vomit fluid is clear.

NOTE TO 2-P/II: 2-P/II is Atropine sulfate. 2-P/II is also anti-

botul and should be administered in conjunction with Atropine.

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
