3. Make the following label revisions:
a. "Collards" and "Onions" are listed twice in the use sites table. Remove one of these duplicates to remove redundancy. Note: the duplicate for collards is found in the listing after "Greens."
b. Revise "Smell grains" to "Small grains" in the use sites table.
c. Separate "Sugar beet" and "Sunflowers" in the use sites table.
4. Amend the EPA Reg. No. to "2749-545."
5. Submit one (1) copy of the revised final printed label for the record.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.
