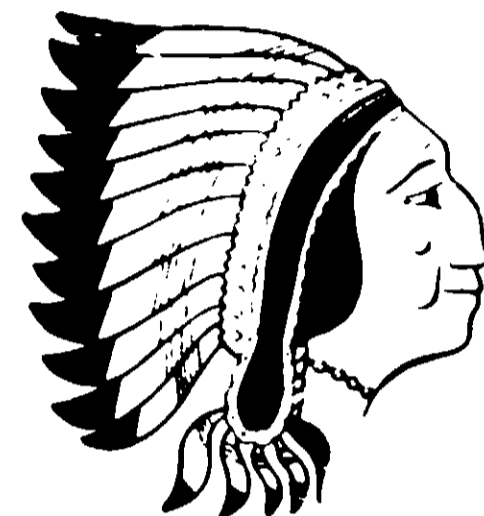
DESCRIPTION OF  
CAL-CHIEF INSECTICIDES

**CAL-CHIEF** contains pyrethrins and a blend of refined deodorized and clarified petroleum distillates. These ingredients, when used as directed, will not stain or discolor fabrics. If, due to overspraying or spillage, fabrics become discolored, discoloration may be removed by dry cleaning. **CAL-CHIEF** weighs 6.7 lbs. per gallon, and has a flash point of 160 F.

**CAL-CHIEF** is formulated for use in any aerosol type fogging equipment to aid in the control of flying and exposed insects. It is especially suitable for use in **flour mills, bakeries, dairies, creameries, packing plants, and other food handling and processing establishments.**

**CAUTION** Harmful if swallowed. Remove or cover fish bowls and aquariums when fogging. Do not direct fog at or near open flame. Remove pets, birds and fish bowls from room before spraying. Use as a space spray in food processing plants only when plant is not in operation. Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered or thoroughly cleaned before using.

**STORAGE** When not in use keep fluid in tightly sealed container in darkened room. Do not expose to heat or light. If stored in steel drum, do not use copper or brass spigot.

**DIRECTIONS**

For best results close all doors, windows and other openings leading to outdoors. Stop fans and blowers, if practical, cover food, and food containers, open cabinet, desk and closet doors and drawers, separate clothing and fabrics, now proceed as follows:

**FOR: FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS, AND FLYING AND EXPOSED MOTHS** - direct fog towards ceiling, dispersed at the rate of 2 to 3 ounces of **CAL-CHIEF** for every ten thousand cubic feet of air space. Allow fog to remain in room for one hour or longer before airing. Repeat as needed.

**FOR: ROACHES, SILVER FISH, EXPOSED WEEVIL, AND SPIDERS** - fog directly into all cracks and crevices, paying particular attention to mouldings, base boards, and broken plaster or wall paper. Fogging with **CAL-CHIEF** (pyrethrum) will kill only the adult insects contacted by the fog, it will not kill the eggs. To avoid reinfestation, repeat treatment at weekly intervals for three weeks and after that as needed. Remember, it takes only one invading female rearing her young to start a new colony. Establishments which have adopted good sanitation programs and which have included in their program weekly foggings with a good pyrethrum insecticide are rarely bothered with these insect pests.
