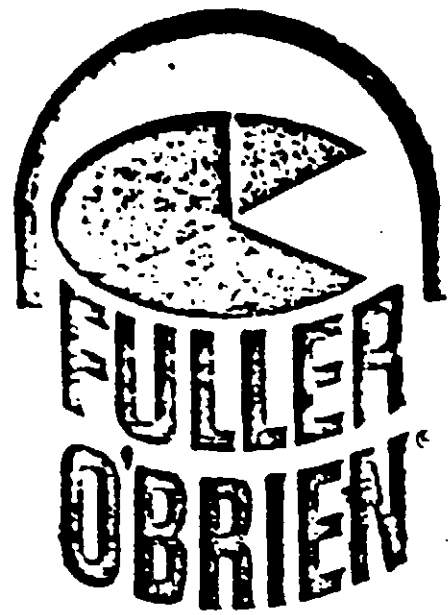
The basic formulation is being accepted under this registration. The acceptability of the alternate formulation cannot be determined until the HED Inerts Review Group has completed it's review.

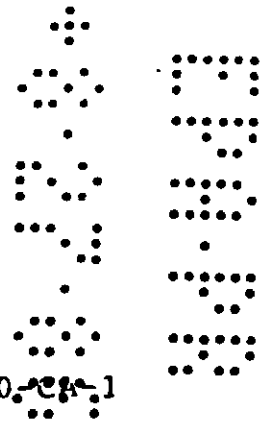

# PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

## HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

**WARNING:**

CONTAINS PETROLEUM DISTILLATES. Use only with adequate ventilation. Avoid breathing of vapor or spray mist. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Causes substantial but temporary eye injury. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before re-use.

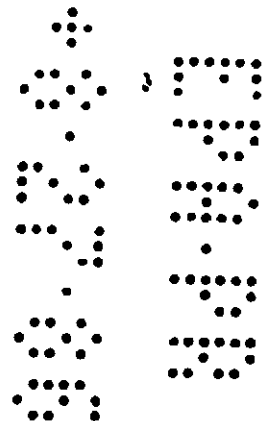

**COMBUSTIBLE:** Do not use, pour, or spill near heat or open flame. In case of fire, use water spray, foam, carbon dioxide or dry chemical.



**Ful-Screen Clear Wood Preservative**

A high quality clear finish as a prime ingredient in a continuous program of protecting exterior wood surfaces, such as rustic siding of cabins, shakes, shingles, and decks.

Protects against mildew and decay producing fungi.

Controls shrinking and swelling.

Resists water and sap staining.

Preserves or restores natural wood color.

For new, weathered, or semi-transparent stained wood use clear or tinted to enhance color of wood.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. This product can be used for all above ground applications. Do not use this product where any portion of the treated wood will be below ground. May be used as a booster or adjunct to pressure treated wood where the wood is to be used on the grounds' surface (e.g., ornamental or landscape timbers). Do not use on wood that will be in contact with food, feed, potable water, or in prolonged dermal (skin) contact. Due to the presence of petroleum distillates in this product, do not use where dairy cattle or livestock can come in contact with treated wood.

**DRYING TIME:** To touch 1-3 hours. Hard: 18 hours.

**COVERAGE:** Up to 150 sq. ft. on new, smooth wood. Rough sawn or porous wood will require more sealer. Apply 2 coats on soil-contacting wood, 3 coats to side and butt ends.

**THINNING:** Not recommended.

**TINTED:** May be tinted with up to 2 fl. oz. of Fulcolorant Universal Tinting Colors, to seal and stain in one operation. Use light-fast colorants.

**PREPARATION:** All surfaces must be clean, sound and dry. Remove dirt, dust, oil, grease, mildew or other foreign matter. Cut and machine wood prior to treatment, if possible. If not, liberally apply three coats of Ful-Screen to all joints, cracks, cut-ends, bolt holes, or other openings.

**APPLICATION:** Although Ful-Screen may be used around desirable plants and shrubs, applying paints and stains often results in splashing or dripping. Therefore, cover desirable plants and shrubs when applying to protect against possible injury. Thoroughly mix Ful-Screen before and occasionally during application. Apply by airless or low-pressure spray or by brush. Pick up sags by brush as they occur. Allow to penetrate, avoid leaving a glossy surface film. Do not use when temperature of surface or air is less than 40 degrees F. For best results and uniformity of appearance, retreat once every three years.

**CLEAN-UP:** Clean spills and tools immediately with mineral spirits or paint thinner.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

**STORAGE:** Do not store near excessive heat.

**DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse container. Rinse thoroughly and wrap in several layers of newspaper before discarding in trash.

**CERTIFIED SATISFACTION:** If after application according to label instructions, you are not satisfied with this product, we will supply, upon proof of purchase, additional paint to correct the unsatisfactory condition, or, a refund of the purchase price.
