The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable, provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. The Child Hazard Warning must precede the signal word.
2. Under your Directions for Use we suggest the following be added, "Wear rubber gloves and," before the wording, "work well into the skin with a slow"
3. The "Precautionary Statements" section should precede the "Directions for Use," and its wording should be revised to read, "May cause eye and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Wash thoroughly after handling. Do not use on cats."
4. A Statement of Practical Treatment must be added to the labeling. We suggest the following statement; however, if your toxicological data suggest otherwise, please submit a draft Statement of Practical Treatment for prior approval:

If swallowed - Call a physician or Poison Control Center
immediately. Drink one or two glasses of

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water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with a finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person.

If inhaled - Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

If on skin - Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

If in eyes - Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.
