2. The statement "**USE ONLY ON DOGS OR CATS**" in bold, all caps must follow immediately after the statement "**READ ENTIRE LABEL BEFORE EACH USE**" identified in item # 1 above.

Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.
