The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all the information submitted with your application to support the Registration Review of the above referenced product in connection with the Permethrin Interim Decision, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable. The label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable.



shipment with the new labeling. In accordance with 40 CFR 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell this product under the previously approved labeling for 12 months from the date of this letter. After 12 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR 152.3.

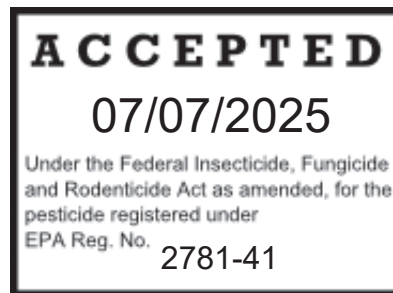

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Hazards to Humans: Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, or using tobacco. Remove and wash contaminated clothing. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals. Groomers or other persons applying this product frequently must wear chemical resistant gloves.

HOLD CONTAINER UPRIGHT, SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING
For indoor use only.

This product will kill fleas up to 14 days on dogs and cats, and will kill ticks for 4 days on dogs and 9 days on cats.

Application of product on pets must only be done indoors. Spray animal at a distance of 8 – 12 inches. Start spraying at the tail, moving the dispenser rapidly and making sure the animal's entire body is covered, including legs and underbody. Fluff the hair as you spray so the spray will penetrate to the skin. The spray should wet the ticks thoroughly.

For cats apply at the rate of 1 second per pound of body weight. For dogs, apply at the rate of 2 seconds per pound of body weight for thin and short haired dogs and up to 8 seconds per pound of body weight for heavy and long haired dogs. For information, call 1-800-326-5225.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal.
