

Inhibitor Concentrate

For Prevention of Scald on Apples in Storage

Active Ingredient—Diphenylamine...11.6%
Inert Ingredients...88.4%

Directions for use

(Please read carefully)

Continuous Dilution:

Use Pennwalt Corp. equipment especially designed for this purpose, with instruction by or under supervision of manufacturer's personnel.

Batch Dilution:

Add one gallon of concentrate to 57 gallons of water to give a treating concentration of 2,000 ppm (0.2%) diphenylamine. For Rome Beauty, Baldwin and Grimes Golden apples add one gallon of concentrate to 115 gallons of water to give a treating concentration of 1,000 ppm (0.1%).

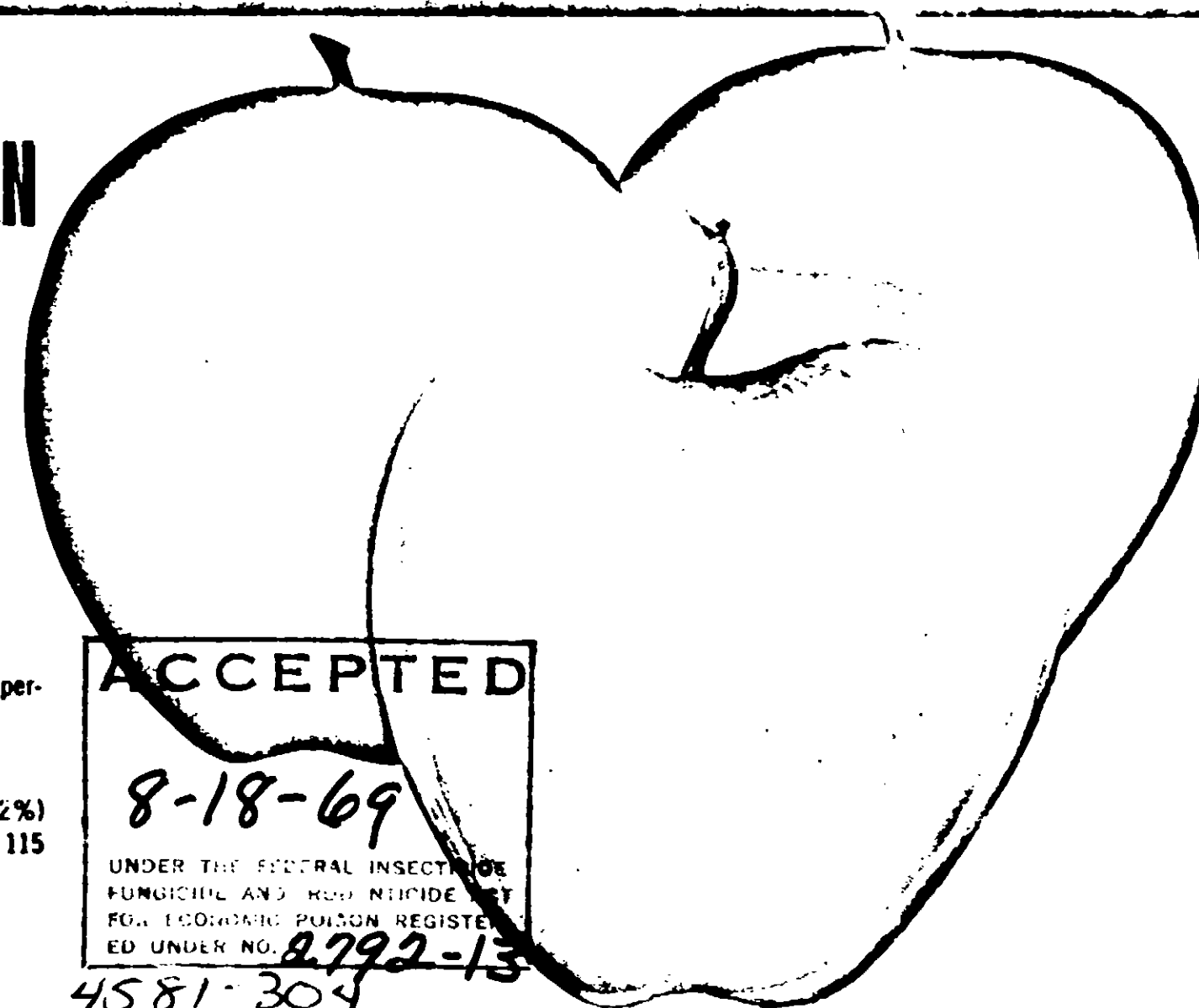
