DIRECTIONS FOR USE (cont.)

FOOD PROCESSING PLANTS: This product is recommended for the use in food processing plants including fruit and vegetable packinghouse. Clean equipment such as conveyor belts, box washers and bin washers with good detergent, follow with a water rinse prior to sanitization with this product. For sanitizing of pre-cleaned food processing equipment, utensils, conveyor belts, conveyor rollers and other packinghouse equipment dilute 1 ounce of Deccosan with 4 gallons of water to provide 200 ppm of active quaternary ammonium compound. Allow a period of 1 minute or more for contact time. Apply the solution by spray or dip as it may be practical. No potable water rinse is required. Follow the recommendations of your local health agency. Allow adequate draining period prior to use of the equipment. A fresh sanitizing solution should be prepared at least daily or more often if the solution becomes diluted or soiled.

Drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Call physician immediately.

FOR DISINFECTION OF NON POROUS SURFACES: (Floor, walls, sink tops, garbage pails etc.)— Remove gross filth or heavy soil, pre-clean all surfaces. Then use 3 to 4 ounces of Deccosan per five gallons of water. Apply with mop or cloth and thoroughly wet the surface. Allow the treated surface to remain wet for 10 minutes. Prepare fresh solution daily or when the solution becomes visibly dirty.
