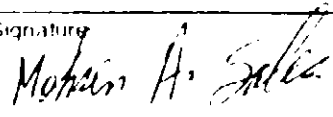

## **DIRECTIONS FOR USE (Cont.)**

### **APPLICATION**

DECCOSAN 320 detergent/disinfectant has been designed specifically for food processing plants, and non-medical institutions where housekeeping is of prime importance.

**DISINFECTION** - To disinfect hard inanimate surfaces (such as walls, floors, table tops), apply solution with mop, cloth, sponge or mechanical sprayer so as to wet all surfaces thoroughly. Allow to remain wet for 10 minutes and then let air dry.

**DILUTION RATES** - General Disinfection - Add 2 ounces DECCOSAN 320 per gallon of water. For heavily soiled areas, a pre-cleaning step is required. Prepare a fresh solution for each use.

**MILDEWSTAT** - To control molds and mildew on hard non-porous surfaces (such as floors, walls, table tops) clean surfaces then add 2 ounces per gallon of water. Apply with a cloth, mop or sponge to surfaces to be treated making sure to wet thoroughly. Let air dry. Prepare a fresh solution for each use. Repeat application at weekly intervals or when mold growth reappears.

**SANITIZATION** - To sanitize previously cleaned and rinsed non-porous food contact surfaces, prepare 200 ppm active quaternary solution by adding 4 ounces to 5 gallons of water. To sanitize immobile items (such as tanks, chopping blocks, counter tops), flood the area with 200 ppm solution or apply with a cloth or sponge, making sure to wet all surfaces completely for at least 60 seconds. Let air dry. Prepare a fresh solution for each use. To sanitize mobile items (where practical), immerse in 200 ppm solution for at least 60 seconds making sure to immerse completely. Remove and let air dry. Prepare a fresh solution daily or more frequently as soil is apparent.

DECCOSAN 320 is a phosphate free cleanser disinfectant and sanitizer designed for general food processing plants and light industrial applications where housekeeping is of prime importance in controlling the hazard of cross contamination. When used as directed DECCOSAN 320 is formulated to disinfect inanimate hard surfaces

(such as walls, floors, sink tops, tables, etc.). For larger areas, the product is designed to provide both general cleaning and disinfecting. In addition, DECCOSAN 320 deodorized those areas which generally are hard to keep fresh smelling, such as storage areas, empty garbage bins and cans, toilet bowls and any other areas which are prone to odors caused by microorganisms.

**EFFICACY TESTS HAVE DEMONSTRATED THAT DECCOSAN 320 IS AN EFFECTIVE BACTERICIDE, FUNGICIDE, IN THE PRESENCE OF ORGANIC MATTER (5% BLOOD SERUM).**

**Mold and MILDEWSTAT** - DECCOSAN 320 controls mold and mildew and the conditions they cause on hard non-porous inanimate surfaces at 2 ounces per gallon dilution.

**SANITIZATION** - When used for sanitization of previously cleaned food equipment food contract items limit active quaternaries to 200 ppm. At this level NO POST-WATER RINSE is required.

**SANITIZATION** - When used for sanitization of previously cleaned equipment effective sanitizer when diluted in water up to 250 ppm hardness (CaCO<sub>3</sub>).
