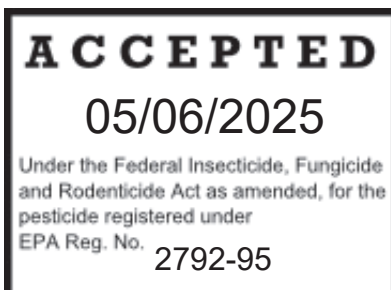

- Pome fruit (crop group 11-10) and all cultivars, varieties and/or hybrids of these;
- Tuberous and corm subgroup crops (subgroup 1C), and all cultivars, varieties and/or hybrids of these.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
