For use on plants, on trees, palms, etc., and shrubs to protect against mealy bugs and honey suckles.

DIRECTIONS:

Make a spray using 2 to 4 tablespoons per gallon of water.

Make first application prior to first sign of disease and maintain preventative schedule through out the season repeating application every 7 to 14 days. Keep new growth protected.

CONTENTS 1 POUND

USE — DUSTING:  
For dusting leaves of trees to help control  
mealy bugs or caterpillars.  
DIRECTIONS:  
Use at least 1 pound to 100 sq. ft. of  
surface leaf of trees. Make final application  
prior to first sign of disease of root  
beetles. Repeat applications every two  
weeks. Repeat over 3 to 4 weeks during heavy  
season of infestation. For control of borers.
