For treating external Screw Worm infestations in horses and mules; but it must not be used on cattle, goats, sheep or swine.  
 Directions: Swab thoroughly with a one-inch paint brush into open wounds and surrounding areas; Push smear into open holes; repeat treatment every seven days until wound heals. Large or severe wounds may need two treatments the first week. Animals being treated should receive constant supervision. For best results in the control and treatment of disease a Veterinarian should be consulted.
