ROOT CONTROL: Copper Sulfate provides a simple and inexpensive means of removing from sewers the roots of trees and shrubs which have penetrated the joints of underground conduits in search of food and water.

HOUSE CONNECTIONS: A dose of one to two pounds of Copper Sulfate per application is sufficient to control ordinary obstructions. This depends on the number and kinds of clogs and trees that surround the area and the length of the connection. Treatment should be repeated at 60-day intervals.

Copper Sulfate must be added through the toilet connections followed by repeated flushing. Never add through sinks or wash basins where corrosion may occur.

Copper Sulfate causes only local killing action to roots that enter the region and no damage to well established trees or shrubs is done. Humco Sulfate crystals are preferred because they dissolve slower and remain in contact longer. If Copper Sulfate Powder is to be used, the dosage should be about 1/2 pound every 2 weeks.

ANTIDOTE: External - Flush with water. If swallowed - Give milk or milkshake. Induce vomiting. CALL PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY.
