DIRECTIONS FOR USE

CUNILATE 2174-PR is recommended for use in low melt point micro-crystalline and scale-wax formulations.

CUNILATE 2174-SUP is recommended for use in high melt point products whenever a stable, active fungicide is required.

Both products are stable at temperatures up to 425°F and can be held at elevated temperatures for considerable periods of time. They may be added at any time to the wax melt and blended in by stirring or agitation.

CUNILATE 2174-PR and CUNILATE 2174-SUP should be used at levels of from 2.5% to 10% depending on the degree of protection required and the environmental conditions to be encountered. Normally, a level of 2.5% is sufficient to provide good protection to paper, paperboard and wood under average use.

HANDLING PRECAUTIONS

All CUNILATES are dark yellowish green and will stain clothing. Care should be taken to prevent splashing of the molten product onto the skin. If splashed on clothing, stains may be removed by dry-cleaning followed by laundering.

HAZARDS TO HUMANS

Causes skin and eye irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or clothing. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid inhalation of vapors. Wear eye protection and rubber gloves when handling.

FIRST AID
