## PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

CUNILATE Quick-Dry Penetrant contains 1.5% CUNILATE #2174-NA and 85% Isopropyl alcohol 99%.

This material is to be used for the treatment of unpainted wooden shelves and other wooden structures in damp cold rooms. The isopropyl alcohol 99% is specified because of its quick drying quality as well as its lack of transference of odor to food.

Because of the low flash point of isopropyl alcohol, due caution must be taken when this penetrant is applied.

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

CUNILATE Quick-Dry Penetrant is excellent for use as a mold or fungus preventative coating on previously cleaned structural surfaces in food processing establishments. Care should be taken to remove or adequately cover food or food processing equipment to prevent food contamination during application of the penetrant.

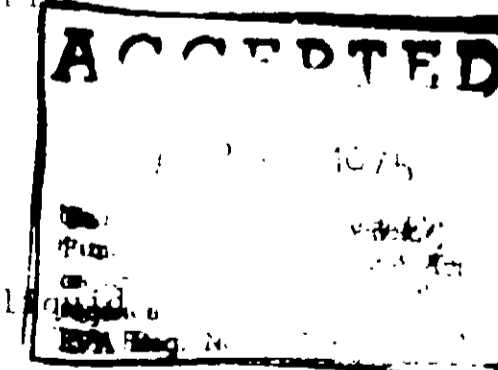
CUNILATE Quick-Dry Penetrant dries quickly and will not produce residual odors. It may be applied by dipping, brushing or spraying techniques. If sprayed, care should be taken to insure complete surface coverage. One gallon will treat an area approximately 250 square feet.

## HANDLING

Since CUNILATE Quick-Dry Penetrant contains isopropanol, proper caution should be taken to insure adequate ventilation. It should not be applied in the presence of heat or open flames. Smoking during application should not be permitted in the area. CUNILATE Quick-Dry Penetrant has a greenish cast and will stain clothing. Suitable work clothing, safety glasses, and work gloves should be used during its application.
